Faith Sharing

Parish Transition:

.....Review of Town Hall

Father Don Oleksiak, Director of the diocesan Clergy Personnel Board, led the Town Hall meeting held on April 28th. Parishioners were invited to attend and provide insight to facilitate the selection of Father Mark's successor. Parishioner turnout was impressive as were the listing of all the ministries that take place at Resurrection. The importance of women's involvement in the church came up repeatedly as well as how much the pastoral team was appreciated.

.....Welcoming New Pastor

Suggestions which were offered to welcome the new pastor included weekend socials with the purpose of his mixing with the congregation; inviting him to council meeting; refreshing his home/office; providing information about the Solon area; encouraging him vocally; and communicating positive expectations.

.....Assist Parish staff with arrival and transition

Lisa Frey distributed information pertaining to parish transitions which would be helpful in preparing for the coming change in leadership. She and Kimberly Ensign will attempt to get Rick Krivanka to address Council about these suggested procedures and possibly to set up a date to meet with a transition committee before the next scheduled Council meeting.

Recruiting of New Council Members

Mark Dobrzynski reported that there is a healthy list of interested parishioners. One potential new member was a guest at this meeting.

Detroit Youth Mission/ Pancake Breakfast

The youth mission presently has 14 children and 6 adults signed up for the Detroit trip to work with the homeless. Coverage of their activities will be on Facebook.

Tom Schneck reported that plans for the pancake breakfast on June 14th are going well. There will be raffle items at the event and advertising in the church bulletin. Breakfast will be served from 10:00 AM until 1:00 PM and thus, through the 11:00 Mass.
