Council Recruitment

Committee Chairman Mike Rubbo said that several parishioners had expressed interest so far. Council Priorities

Father Mark, Tom Schneck and Mike Rubbo urged the Council not to be discouraged, but instead to look at the good already being done, and the Parishioners already inspired to service, through Out Onto The Streets. "We need to leave room to let things happen," Mike said. "If we've started the ball rolling, we've accomplished what we wanted," Father said.

Mary Grace Poidomani has ordered a three-panel room divider as a "kiosk" to celebrate service by Parishioners and to encourage them to get/remain involved. She hopes to have it in place by Father's Day.
