Preliminary

Faith Sharing

Mark Olszewski began Faith Sharing with the reading of Luke 19: 28-40

Introduction of Music Ministry

Julie Parrotta continued Faith Sharing by asking council members to share the names of saints who have influenced their lives and helped shape the parish community. Julie has included a litany of saints in several liturgies and is seeking to include more saints.

Following this exchange, Julie introduced herself to council members, gave a history of how she arrived at Resurrection and discussed what she hoped to accomplish. She has begun engaging young people in the music ministry as cantors and hopes to incorporate contemporary and world music in the services. She explained that increasing youth involvement is not an immediate response but more of a lengthy, evolving process.

Quick Review of Year of Mercy Project

Kimberly Ensign and her sub-committee of Dennis Olsheski, Dottie Eidam and Bethany Koenig presented council with a compilation of ways to engage the parish in the Jubilee Year of Mercy. Rather than creating a booklet, the consensus of Council was to post different ways of participating on both the Church website and in a weekly bulletin section. The Pastoral Staff will review the handout and report back to council.

Outdoor Nativity Presence

Father Tom elicited council's comments on how to handle the outdoor Christmas display of the Nativity to prevent a re-occurrence of the 2015 theft of the Christ Child and manger. Council members suggested moving the display closer to the church building, keeping lights on through the night and using ground stakes on the various pieces. General enthusiasm was expressed for continuing the outdoor display.

Discernment Update

Rick Ijams presented the plan for the annual recruitment of new council members. On the weekend of April 2nd and 3rd, speakers will deliver the same information about council in a short one minute announcement following mass. Volunteers include Marty Motsco at the 5:30 Mass, Dotty Smercina at the 9:00 Mass and possibly Kimberly Ensign at the 11:00 Mass. Rick and Dori Ijams will also be available in the Gathering Area after each mass to answer any questions from parishioners. Announcements regarding the opening of council to new members will be made in the church bulletin and also the church e-mail blast. It was suggested that there also be a hyperlink to the "Way of Proceeding" document.

Comments from Pastoral Team

Lisa Frey mentioned the upcoming "Soup and Stations" event this Friday; the Easter Basket giveaway is in need of laundry items; Resurrection is serving a much larger need for food baskets this Easter; young students are encouraged to help load cars with food baskets on Monday, March 21st.

Terry Battaglia reported on upcoming youth happenings in the parish: Lock-In on April 15th; Parents Night Out on May 20th; Mission Trip this year in Cleveland at St. Aloysius; Summer Camp June 20th-24th and Vacation Bible School July 11-15th.

Father Tom reported on plans for: 1) a parish Annual Service Day to be held on September 17th from 9:00-2:00 PM followed by 5:30 Mass and dinner. Volunteers numbering around the goal of 125 will work twelve different sites; 2) the addition of 7 lectors and 3 cantors of junior high and college age; 3) an adult faith formation program in October dealing with scripture and paintings; 4) a promotional piece about Resurrection to be designed by a graphic artist for residents moving into our area; and 5) a Sunday Offertory Enhancement program in conjunction with the Finance Council in the Fall. Additionally, Father Tom commended the Social Justice committee for the informative community forum held at Resurrection on "Heroin."

Julie Parrotta reported on the Music in a Sacred Space event scheduled for May 5th. It will be both an afternoon and evening event for the first time. Hopefully the afternoon will see an audience that finds it difficult to attend evening functions, such as residents of Stratford Commons.
