

50th Anniversary Year

Trivison Scholarship Fund





About the Scholarship Fund

At its inception, the fund was used to supplement tuition expenses of students in need. Over time, the Voucher system grew, and now nearly all students at the Archbishop Lyke and St Aloysius schools receive vouchers to cover the stated tuition. However, the cost of educating a child exceeds the voucher amount by more than \$4000. While the scholarship funds may not in the narrow sense be used to pay the Trivison stated tuition, the Scholarship Fund will continue to help to cover the cost of educating children in need.

Scholarship History

To celebrate the Church of the Resurrection's 25th anniversary, and to honor the retirement of founding pastor Fr Louis J. Trivison, the Trivison scholarship was established in 1996 to support Catholic education for young people in the Diocese of Cleveland, particularly in the Mt Pleasant neighborhood served by Epiphany Catholic Church.

Purpose

The purpose of the fund is to provide solely for the education of the students during the school day as determined by the school principal. After-school programs, band camp, sporting programs and the like, while worthwhile, do not fall under the design of the Trivison Scholarship.

Participating Schools

Now in its 25th year, while we continue our partnership with Archbishop James P Lyke School, the fund has grown to include St Aloysius-St Agatha school in Cleveland's Glenville neighborhood.

Distribution Policy

An annual appeal to the parish is made on the third weekend in October. Donations to this fund are only used following the fund guidelines. Whatever is received in donations to the Trivison Scholarship Fund in one calendar year will be distributed in the subsequent year. In addition, up to 5% of the principle as of the calendar year end could be distributed in the subsequent year.

Oversight

The Trivison Scholarship Fund falls under the purview of the Church of the Resurrection Charitable Giving Advisory Board, whose members include a liaison with the parish Finance Council as well as the parish Pastoral Staff.

The Trivison Scholarship Fund helps cover the cost of educating children in need.
